|------------------------------------|-------------|--|
| Excellent /отлично | A | Outstanding achievements, with minor, almost negligible deficiencies |
| Good /хорошо | B | Well-performed work with some deficiencies |
| Satisfactory/ удовлетворительно | E | Performance meets only minimum criteria |
| Passed/зачет | | The final test of the subject was passed without varied grade mark |
| Fail/Неудовлетворительно | F-Fx | Fail |

Students are only permitted to enroll in the next semester of study and awarded a diploma if they have passing grades in each subject of the curriculum.
